ORDER:

In the reference 1st read above orders were issued introducing Group Insurance Scheme to the State Government Employees in place of Family Benefit Scheme with effect from 01.11.1984. According to Para 9 of the reference 1st read above, the accumulations of Savings Fund part and Insurance Fund part shall carry interest at the rates prescribed by Government from time to time.

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2. In the reference 2nd read above, orders were issued for apportioning the subscription of each unit of Rs. 10/- between Insurance Fund and Savings Fund in the ratio of Rs. 3.125/- and Rs. 6.875/- respectively.

3. In terms of the recommendation of the Committee constituted to review the working of the Andhra Pradesh State Employees Group Insurance Scheme in Government orders 3rd above orders were issued for revision of rate of subscription each unit from Rs. 10/- to Rs. 15/- with effect from 01.11.1994. In modification of the Para 9 of the Government orders 1st read above, orders were issued in Government orders 4th read above, for fixing the interest on the accumulations of the Savings Fund of the Member of the Scheme for the State as a whole and shall be paid at the Rate of 12 % per annum compounded Quarterly with effect from 01.11.1994. Further, in the Government orders 5th read above, the apportionment of the subscription of each unit Rs. 15/- between Insurance Fund and Savings Fund was fixed in the ratio of Rs. 4.50/- and Rs. 10.50/- respectively with effect from 01.11.1994. The amount of insurance coverage will be Rs. 15,000/- for each unit of subscription.

4. The rate of interest on accumulations of Savings Fund of the Member of the Scheme and the interest on the Insurance Fund from time to time is as follows:

5. In the reference 14th read above, Government has issued orders to reduce the rate of interest from 8.8 % to 8.7 % per annum with effect from 01.04.2014 on the Provident Funds and other similar funds i.e., Andhra Pradesh Government Life Insurance Funds maintained by the Government of Andhra Pradesh on par with rates of Government of India until further orders.

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6. In view of the above circumstances and after careful examination of the matter, Government hereby order that the revised rates of interest on the Andhra Pradesh Group Insurance Savings Fund shall be allowed at 8.7 % per annum from 01.04.2015 onwards. The Tables are revised and issued for the period covering from 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2016. The revised tables of benefits I, II and III, III (A) to III (U) on Savings Fund of Andhra Pradesh State Employees Group Insurance Scheme – 1984 on cessation of membership during the period from **01.04.2015 to 31.03.2016** are appended herewith for making payments under the Scheme.

7. These orders and Tables shall come in force **with effect from 01.04.2015**.

8. The Sanctioning Authorities / Drawing and Disbursement Officers / Treasury Officers/ District Audit Officers / Pay and Accounts Officers / Director of Works Accounts are requested to keep in view of the appended Table while sanctioning and making the final payments under Group Insurance Scheme for proper implementation of the Scheme. Further, the following instructions shall also be scrupulously followed:

1. The Head of the Department / Drawing and Disbursement Officer shall be held responsible for sanctioning the Group Insurance Scheme final payments. If any excess payments are found, the difference amount shall be collected from the sanctioning authority and such Officers are liable for disciplinary action.
2. The Drawing and Disbursement Officer shall recover the correct rate of subscription according to the eligible group of the employees. For any excess / less recovery, the Drawing and Disbursement Officer concerned shall be held responsible.
3. The Director of Insurance (FAC), Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad shall conduct a regular Audit of all claims paid under Group Insurance Scheme and send a report to the Head of the Department concerned.
4. The Head of the Department concerned shall take action against the erring officials who are responsible for the excess / less recoveries wherever they are detected.
5. Any excess payment made, if found during the Audit by the Directorate of Insurance, the same shall be immediately recovered from the concerned and remitted through Challan to the concerned Head of Account by the Drawing and Disbursement Officer and the fact of remittance shall invariably be communicated to the Directorate of Insurance.
6. If an employee's subscription is not recovered during his Service Period, the total subscription along with interest shall be recovered from the payments admissible to him.
7. All the Heads of Offices should **take prompt action for recording the necessary subscription entries in the Service Registers of the employees under proper attestation every year at the close of March** and a Certificate shall be recorded in the Service Book of each employee that subscription to the Scheme at the appropriate rates have been recovered for the period **from April to March**. The entries shall be attested by the Drawing and Disbursing Officer.
8. As per G. O. Ms. No. 910, Finance (Admn.II) Department, dated: 28.10.2002. **"Sanctioning authority shall send a copy of sanction orders of the Group Insurance Scheme Payment including calculation slip to the Directorate of Insurance for verification"**.

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9. The Director of Insurance (FAC) is further advised to obtain the revised rates of interest from the Government of India and submit the proposals to the Government in advance every year so as to issue orders in time.

10. The Director of Insurance (FAC), Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad shall take further necessary action in the matter accordingly.

Under the existing rules, the Andhra Pradesh Government Life Insurance Department issues the Endowment Insurance policies to the Government employees based on the maximum insurable age of 55 years and these policies will mature on the insured attaining age of 60 years. In the Government orders fourth to sixth read above, the compulsory premium rates under the policy had been revised as and when the Revised Pay Scales were implemented to the State Government Employees including the Public Transport Department based on the recommendations of the successive Pay Revision Commission and the existing rates are prescribed in the G.O. read above.

2. In the reference 2nd read above, the Government enhanced the age of superannuation of the State Government employees from (60) years to (62)years.

3. In the reference 3rd read above, the Government have issued orders introducing the Revised Pay Scales 2022

4. Consequent to enhancement of age of superannuation from (60) years to (62) years and introduction of the Revised Pay Scales 2022, the Director of Insurance A.P in the reference 10th read above, has sent proposals for enhancement of the maximum insurable age from 55 years to 57 years and to revise the slab rates according to the RPS 2022 along with the sum assured table applicable to various categories of employees.

5. After careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Insurance, A.P, Government hereby order that the maximum Insurable age under the Andhra Pradesh Government Life Insurance Scheme be raised from 55 years to 57 years and the rates of compulsory premium under the scheme shall be revised as detailed below and accordingly issue the following instructions

- All the employees shall have to increase their monthly premium as per the revised rates applicable to their basic pay as on date and forward the requisite proposal form to the concerned APGLI office through their DDOs only.
- Unless proposal forms are submitted to the extent of their monthly premium contribution and policies obtained, the employees will not get Insurance coverage for the enhanced premium paid.
- The Drawing and Disbursing officers have to deduct first premium deduction as per slab rates only.
- A Policyholder can enhance his premium contribution only after successful completion of one year of service.

- e) An employee who desires to get more insurance coverage can increase his/her further premium voluntarily up to 15% of his basic pay, including total premium of all his/her policies by supersession of the existing maximum limit of premium. i.e. 20% of basic pay as per G.O.Ms.No.26 Finance & Planning (FW.Admn-II) Dept., dated 22.02.1995 with as usual terms and conditions of submission of Good Health Certificate issued by Civil Assistant Surgeon or equivalent cadre Medical officer and a certificate containing particulars of medical leaves for last three years of enhancement in case of Employees who enhanced their premium more than 8% of their basic pay.
- f) An employee who is already a subscriber of the fund having policy/ policies, and is aged below 57 years can enhance the premium for additional policies. However, he/she should submit his application in the prescribed proforma before he actually attains the age of 57 years.
- g) Under any circumstances proposal form shall not be accepted if the applicant has already attained the age of 57 years on the date of submission of his application, notwithstanding the fact that the amount was already deducted in the monthly pay bills. Such amounts shall be treated as unauthorized amounts and refunded to the individual following the usual procedure.
- h) An employee who is already a subscriber of the Fund but is aged above (57) years cannot increase the Premium for additional policies. However, in respect of those employees, recovery of existing premium shall continue for the existing policies till the date of Last Premium due of such policy.
- i) In respect of the Policyholders who are suffering from 1) Heart 2) Kidney 3) Lungs and 4) Cancer Ailments their subscription will be restricted to the Compulsory Monthly premium only and subject to the present health condition of proponent.

7. These orders shall come into force with effect from 01.11.2022 and the above revised premium rates shall be recovered from the pay of October,2022, payable on 01.11.2022.

8. The Drawing and Disbursing officers concerned are solely responsible for effecting the recovery of revised premiums from all the eligible employees i.e. who are below 57 years of age from the pay of October 2022, payable on 01.11.2022 duly forwarding the requisite proposals forms and obtaining the requisite policies from the APGLI department invariably. If the fixation is delayed for any reason, the premium shall be recovered only from the month of drawl of pay fixation arrears and in such case, no arrears of premium shall be collected.

9. To ensure proper implementation of the scheme the HODs / DDOs are requested to follow the above instructions scrupulously.
10. The Director of Treasuries and Accounts, Andhra Pradesh and the Director of works and Accounts, Andhra Pradesh shall issue suitable instructions to all the District Treasury Officers/ Treasury Officers / Pay and Accounts Officers under their control, to ensure that the above revised premium rates with reference to new pay slabs are implemented from the pay of October,2022 payable on 01.11.2022 and ensure percent coverage of eligible employees under Andhra Pradesh Government Life Insurance Scheme. The Districts Treasuries and Sub-Treasuries / Pay and Accounts Officers (works) , and the Pay and Accounts Officer, Andhra Pradesh should verify the collection of premium as per the slab rates before passing the salary bills.
11. The Director of Insurance , Andhra Pradesh, Shall ensure that policies are issued to all the subscribing employees expeditiously after the applications are received in his department duly following the normal procedure.
12. All the Departments of Secretariat / Head of Departments are requested to issue suitable instructions to their subordinate offices to ensure that all eligible employees are brought under the Andhra Pradesh Government Life Insurance Scheme.

ORDER:

1. In the G.O. first read above, that has been amended in the G.Os., 4th and 5th read above, the then Government of pre organised Andhra Pradesh State launched "Employees Health Scheme" with effect from 05-12-2013, to provide cashless treatment to the employees, pensioners and their dependent family members in empanelled network hospitals for the listed therapies notified in G.O.Ms.No.176 HM&FW (M2) Dept dated 01-11-2013, duly replacing the reimbursement of expenditure incurred for inpatient care subject to the provisions of APIMA Rules, 1972.

2. Consequent on reorganization of Andhra Pradesh, Government has reviewed the implementation of the Employees Health Scheme. After careful consideration of the matter, Government hereby issue the following orders in modification of the orders issued in the Government Orders first to fourth read above, with reference to the "Employees Health Scheme"

A. The Scheme, which was originally launched with effect from 05-12-2013, shall be implemented with all the following modifications, in a full-fledged manner, with immediate effect. Health cards to all the remaining beneficiaries shall be issued immediately.

B. In the first phase the following categories of beneficiaries will be covered.

a) Serving employees:

- (i) All regular State Government Employees, as defined under the Fundamental Rules (FR), including Provincialised work charged employees; and
- (ii) Provincialised employees of Local Bodies

b) Retired employees:

- (i) All Service Pensioners;
- (ii) Family pensioners and;
- (iii) Re-employed service pensioners

C. The Employees / Pensioners health cards shall be seeded with Aadhar data, which shall be the basis for Biometric identification under Employees Health Scheme .

D. Steering Committee under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, as envisaged in the G.O., first read above, shall be constituted immediately by including ten (10) members of the recognized associations of the NGO's, Pensioner's Gazetted Officers Association and proportionate member of officers to be nominated by the Government. The General Administration (Services) will issue specific orders defining the composition Steering Committee.

- E. The Steering Committee shall review the implementation of the scheme periodically and make appropriate recommendations for improving the effectiveness and efficiency of the scheme to the Government.
 - F. Out of one thousand eight hundred and eighty five (1885) procedures notified in G.O.Ms.No.176 HM&FW (M2) Dept dated 01-11-2013, three hundred and forty seven (347) procedures, which were earlier reserved exclusively for Government network hospitals, shall be permitted for treatment in all Network hospitals i.e., both Government and private hospitals. This, will, however, be reviewed after 6 months of implementation for taking a suitable decision on reservation of these procedures for Government hospitals.
 - G. The following rates are accepted for the Percutaneous Transluminal Coronary Angioplasty (PTCA) procedure with Stent:
 - (i) PTCA with bare metal Stent - Rs.55,000/-
 - (ii) PTCA with drug eluting Stent - Rs.65,000/-
 - H. The empanelled hospitals which have National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Healthcare Providers (NABH) accreditation will be paid 25% over and above the package prices fixed for non-NABH Hospital, for surgical and medical procedures, which shall include pre-admission OP evaluation.
 - I. The deductions from the salary / pension of the employees / pensioners towards contribution under the Scheme, shall be effected from the salary / pension pertaining to November, 2014 payable on 01-12-2014. Medical reimbursement under APIMA Rules, 1972 will not be allowed for the treatment undergone on and after 01-12-2014. Finance Department will issue instructions to all the Drawing & Disbursing Officers, Pension Payment Officers / Sub-Treasury Officers accordingly.
 - J. The benefits enumerated above shall be implemented within the estimated annual budget of Rs.220 crores, which is derived from 40% contributions from employees / pensioners and 60% contribution by the Government.
 - K. The Finance Department will issue separate orders outlining the procedure and for advancing funds to the Aarogyasri Health Care Trust from the monthly contributions based on the utilisation and settlement of claims.
 - L. The Finance department will issue orders for reimbursement of expenditure incurred by Aarogyasri Trust towards claims payment and administrative expenditure under Employees Health Scheme between 1-11-2013 and 31-10-2014.
 - M. The expenditure incurred shall be reviewed by the Steering Committee headed by Chief Secretary after six months of implementation, and the Committee shall make recommendation on revision of contributions or any other changes if found necessary.
3. The General Administration Department, the Finance Department and the Chief Executive Officer, Aarogyasri Health Care Trust shall take necessary further action in the matter.
5. This Order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide their U.O.No.304/A1/EBS.V/2014, Dated .29-10-2014.

Was withdrawn in G.O.Ms.No. 513 Finance (Pen.I) Dept. dt. 27-11-1962 and reiterated not to accord any sanctions for payment of insurance premia out of G.P.F. accumulations as per Cir Memo. No. 3109/477/A/Pen.II/2003-04 dt. 31-3-2004 of Finance (Pensions.II) Dept.

PAYMENTS UNDER GPF CSS AMOUNTS

As and when the Government releases the Dearness Allowance to the State Government employees, the arrears relating to certain period shall be ordered to be adjusted to the G.P.F. Accounts of employees. In respect of employees who are not having regular G.P.F. Accounts, the arrears due to them shall be credited to the G.P.F. CSS Account under the Head of Account 8009-01-101-03 from the regular departmental head of account at first instance. Later the entire amount credited under the above head of account along with interest shall be adjusted by way of transfer as and when the employees are assigned the G.P.F. Account Number to the regular G.P.F. or Class IV G.P.F. as the case may be. Except that, NO cash

payment shall be made from G.P.F. CSS Account to the serving employees. Cash payments shall be made to the retired persons and in death cases only. For this purpose a register should be maintained at the treasury concerned in the following proforma duly noting the required information. While making payment/adjustment the amount and other information shall be reconciled with the existing information then only the process will be completed.

PROCEDURE FOR MAINTENANCE OF CLASS-IV GPF ACCOUNTS

[Cir. Memo. No. 29404/100/GPF/Pen.II/94 dt. 9-10-95 of Finance & Plg.[FW.Pen.II]Dept]

- 1] All Last Grade Employees after completion of 5 years continuous service and whose date of retirement is at least 10 years ahead, shall be eligible to subscribe to the Fund Compulsorily at 4% of their pay, who are not having regular G.P.F. account with Accountant General, A.P. Hyderabad.
- 2] A nine digit code number is assigned to each subscriber, first 2 digits consist of District Code, Second 3 digits consist of Departmental code and last four digits consist the individual code number.
- 3] All the subscribers should submit the nomination forms as required under rule 7 of GPF (AP) Rules in triplicate along with the application form.
- 4] Separate schedules in triplicate for deduction of G.P.F. of Last Grade Employees Shall be enclosed to the pay bill.
- 5] (a) When a last grade employee under this scheme is transferred from one office within the same district, the G.P.F. Account Number will not change.
(b) If the transfer of the employee from one District to another, the G.P.F. Account Number shall undergo a change. The Head of the Office shall forward the G.P.F. Ledger Account of Subscriber along with the original nomination to the new Head of Office. The new DTO shall allot the new account number and intimate the same to the previous Head of the Office.
- 6] Every DDO should enclose a copy of the individual ledger sheet maintained by them after posting the interest calculated in respect of each subscriber, to the Pay Bill for the month of March payable in April (without taking into account) of the subscription for the month of March but taking into account the advances if any drawn during the month of March also. They Pay Bills for the month of March should not be passed by Treasury without the copy of the individual ledger sheet enclosed, if the bill contains salary of the Last Grade Servants whose G.P.F. account is maintainable by the Treasury.

In supersession of earlier instructions issued in the reference third and fourth read above comprehensive guidelines for sanction of **Incentive Increments** to the teachers for acquiring additional qualifications i.e. M.Phil./PhD. Etc., are given here under:

The Principals of all Government Degree Colleges/Correspondents of Aided Degree Colleges are informed that while revising UGC Pay Scales to the teachers Government also ordered incentive increments to the teachers for having Ph.D./M.Phil. and other higher qualifications, as under:

- Five Non-compounded advance increments shall be admissible to the teachers/Librarians/Physical Directors for having Ph.D. Degree at the entry level of recruitment
- Two Non compounded advance increments shall be admissible for having M.Phi. Degree at the time of recruitment.

-
- Teachers/Librarians/Physical Education personnel who complete their Ph.D. degree while in service shall be entitled to 3 non compounded increments.
 - Teachers/Librarians/Physical Education personnel who acquire M.Phil. Degree or a Post Graduate degree in a professional course recognized by the relevant Statutory Body/Council, while in service, shall be entitled to one advance increment.

Keeping in view the said Government Orders the Principals of Government Degree Colleges/Correspondents of Private Aided Degree and Oriental Colleges are directed to sanction advance increments to the teachers who acquire higher qualification viz., Ph.D./M.Phil., etc., While scrutinizing such proposals the Principals/Correspondents shall follow the following guidelines:

1. To direct the teachers seeking incentive increments for having Ph.D. at the entry level as per eligibility, to furnish a certificate from the University that Ph.D. Degree is awarded to the teacher by following the process of admission, registration, course work and external evaluation as defined by the UGC at para 3.2.2. of G.O.Ms.No.14 Education, dated: 20.02.2010.
2. To sanction advance increments irrespective of the fact whether the teachers were exempted from NET/SLET for possessing Ph.D.
3. That the advancement increments will not be sanctioned in the pay band of 37400-67000 + 9000 AGP in respective of teachers acquired Ph.D./M.Phil. while in service as clarified in Govt.Memo.No.6882/UE.II/2010-2, dated: 24.01.2011.
4. That the teachers who have already availed the benefit of advance increments as per the existing scheme that was prevailing prior to issuance of G.O. 14 Education, dated: 20.02.2010 (i.e. in terms of G.O.Ms.No.208 Education, dated: 29.06.1999) are not entitled for increments under the present revised scheme
5. As clarified by the Government vide reference second read above each non compoundable increment has to be calculated separately and the amount so arrived may be multiplied by

number of increments to be sanctioned. There after the total amount may be merged with basic pay of the employee. Admissible allowances are allowed on such advance non compounded increments.

Example:

"the increments have to be calculated on Rs.15600-6000 AGP @ 3% i.e. Rs.648 rounded to Rs.650. In case a teacher is entitled for 5 non compounded increments the amount of Rs.650 has to be multiplied by 5 (i.e. 650×5) equal to Rs.3250/- and in case of two non compoundable increments it has to be $\text{Rs.}650 \times 2 = \text{Rs.}1300$ ".

The Principals are directed to calculate the advance increments in the above manner in the pay band of 15600-39100 only.

6. The non compounded Advance increments shall be allowed with effect from 01.09.2008.
7. Increments to teachers who acquire Ph.D. prior to 01.01.1996

Further, The Principals/Correspondents are informed that Government vide G.O.Ms.No.294 Education, dated: 20.12.2008 while making amendment to para 4 of G.O.Ms.No.208 Education, dated: 29.06.1999 ordered that a teacher who acquired Ph.D. Degree prior to 01.01.1996 and not benefited in earlier schemes will be entitled for two advancement increments payable from 27.07.1998.

Hence, they are also directed to sanction two advance increments to those who acquired Ph.D. Degree prior to 01.01.1996 and not benefited in earlier schemes. Such increments are payable from 01.09.1998 and shall be shown as Personal Pay (PP) and shall not be merged with the Pay.

The Principals of Government Degree Colleges/Correspondents of Aided Degree Colleges are directed to adhere the instructions scrupulously while clearing the proposals, failing which the matter will be viewed seriously and the Principals/Correspondents concerned will be personally held responsible for any lapse. Action as per Conduct Rules and as per the provisions of Education Act will be initiated as and when such lapses come to the notice of the Commissioner.

The receipt of these proceedings shall be acknowledged.

ORDER:

1. In the order second read above, the Government constituted the Tenth Pay Revision Commission (PRC) to make recommendations on a range of terms-of-reference (TOR) addressing the pay and allowances of employees serving the Government of Andhra Pradesh and the pension and family pension of those who had served the Government.
2. The Pay Revision Commission in its report submitted to the Government made certain recommendations relating to the consolidation of Pension/ Family Pension, enhancement of minimum pension and allied assistance.
3. The Government after careful consideration of the recommendation of Pay Revision Commission hereby order that:
 - i. the existing Pension/Family Pension, in respect of those retired or died while in service prior to July 01, 2013, and in the case of family pensioners who are in receipt of Family pension as on July 01, 2013, s h a l l be consolidated, by adding 43% of basic Pension/ basic Family Pension as fitment and merging the Dearness Relief @ 63.344% admissible on July 01, 2013. It shall be known as the Revised Consolidated Basic Pension/ Revised Consolidated Basic Family Pension.
 - ii. While consolidating the Pension, the additional quantum paid to pensioners on attaining the specified ages, which is shown distinctly, should be ignored.
 - iii. This Revised Consolidated Basic Pension or Revised Consolidated Basic Family Pension shall come into force with effect from July 01, 2013, notionally. The monetary benefit shall be allowed with effect from June 02, 2014.

- iv. As regards the arrears on account of consolidation of Pension/Family pension/Financial Assistance from June 02, 2014 to March 31, 2015, orders will be issued separately. The consolidated Pension/Family Pension shall be paid in cash from the month of April 2015 onwards.
4. While fixing the consolidated basic pension/ basic family pension as above, part of a rupee, if any arrived, should be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
5. The Interim Relief paid from January 01, 2014 to June 01, 2014 shall not be recovered. The Interim Relief paid for the period beyond June 02, 2014, shall be adjusted from the monetary benefit payable on account of revision of consolidated basic pension consolidated basic family pension.
6. A ready reckoner has been appended to this order as Annexure -I. This ready reckoner can be used as reference for payment of the arrears of pension and fixation of Revised Consolidated Basic Pension/Revised Consolidated Basic Family Pension ordered above.
7. In the case of employees who retired on or after June 02, 2014, the pension shall be calculated on the pay in Revised Pay Scales 2015 only.
8. The employees who retired between July 01, 2013 and June 01, 2014 are eligible for revision of their pay in the Revised Pay Scales 2015, notionally as per the orders issued in the G.O. 6th read above. As such, the pensions of these employees have to be revised notionally based on the revised pay in Revised Pay Scales, 2015 and monetary benefit should be allowed from June 02, 2014, only.
9. The Government hereby order for payment of Dearness Relief on the Revised Consolidated Basic Pension/ Revised Consolidated Basic Family Pension as well as on the Pension/ Family Pension fixed with reference to the pay drawn in the Revised Pay Scales 2015 at the rates applicable from time to time with effect from January 01, 2014 and July 01, 2014 as indicated below.

10. The Dearness Relief shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee. These orders are applicable to:
 - a. All Government Pensioners governed by A.P. Revised Pension Rules, 1980
 - b. Service pensioners who retired or died prior to July 01, 2013.
 - c. Family pensioners who are in receipt of pension as on July 01, 2013.
 - d. Provisional Pensioners and Anticipatory Pensioners.

11. The above consolidation of pension does not apply to:
- a) Those who are drawing pension/ family pension on Revised U.G.C./ICAR/ AICTE Pay Scales.
 - b) Pensioners/Family Pensioners of the members of the Andhra Pradesh State Higher Judicial Service and Andhra Pradesh State Judicial Service.
 - c) Financial Assistance grantees who are not getting Dearness Relief.
 - d) Those who are appointed on or after 01.09.2004.
 - e) Retired Members of the All India Services
12. Revised Consolidated Basic Pension now sanctioned shall be with reference to the existing basic Pension, that is, including commuted portion of Pension. As such, the commuted portion of pension, which remained unrestored, should be deducted from the Revised Consolidated Basic Pension while making monthly disbursements.
13. In respect of pensioners and family pensioners who are re-employed, employed, their pension/ family pension shall also be notionally consolidated and Revised Consolidated Basic Pension/ Revised Consolidated Basic Family pension arrived at notionally. The pay drawn by the re-employed pensioners during the period of re-employment shall also be re-fixed taking into account the Revised Consolidated Basic Pension. Dearness Relief beyond July 01, 2013, will not be admissible to them during the period of re-employment as per the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.145, Finance and Planning (FW.PSC) Department dated 16.10.2000.
14. At the time of noting Revised Consolidated Basic Pension on the Pension Payment Order, the Pension Disbursing Officer shall simultaneously calculate and note the corresponding Revised Consolidated Basic Enhanced Family Pension and Revised Consolidated Basic Normal Family Pension on the Pension Payment orders. Similarly, in case where Enhanced Family Pension is being paid, the Normal Family Pension to be payable in future should also be consolidated and noted on the Pension Payment Orders.
15. The pension disbursing officers shall communicate the amount of Revised Consolidated Basic Pension and Revised Consolidated Basic Enhanced Family Pension /Revised Consolidated Basic Normal Family Pension to all the service pensioners, family pensioners and obtain their acknowledgment in token of having received the same. Simultaneously, the details of Revised Consolidated Basic Pension/ Revised Consolidated Basic Family Pension shall be kept in the treasury website.
16. Government also hereby order that the existing Minimum Pension of Rs. 3,350 per month shall be enhanced to Rs.6,500 per month. This enhancement shall come into force with effect from July 01, 2013, with the monetary benefit accruing from June 02, 2014.
17. In respect of pensioners whose Revised Consolidated Basic Pension/ Revised Consolidated Basic Family Pension falls short of Rs.6,500 per month, the same shall be raised to Rs.6,500 per month.
18. Enhancement of minimum pension shall apply to those pensioners referred to in Para-10 above and the Pensioners who are in receipt of Family Pension under

G.O.Ms.No.83, Finance and Planning (FW. Pen-I) Department, dated 05.03.1983 and G.O.Ms.No.314, Finance and Planning (FW. Pen-I) Department, dated 21.11.1983.

19. The minimum pension shall include the commuted portion of pension. As such commuted portion of pension has to be deducted from the minimum pension of Rs.6,500 per month while making monthly disbursement except in respect of pensioners whose commutation is restored as per the existing orders.

20. The Government also hereby order that the existing Financial Assistance of Rs.3,350 per month shall be revised and placed at the minimum of family pension of Rs.6,500 per month. No Dearness Relief will be admissible on this Financial Assistance. This enhancement shall come into force with effect from July 01, 2013, with the monetary benefit from June 02, 2014.

21. In respect of pensioners drawing two pensions viz. Service Pension and Family Pension, both pensions shall separately be eligible for enhancement to a minimum of Rs.6,500 per month. The employed Family Pensioner shall be entitled for payment of Dearness Relief on Family Pension irrespective of the fact that he/ she is getting Dearness Allowance on his/ her pay. This provision, however, shall not be applicable to the Government employees who are appointed on compassionate grounds.

22. All Pension Disbursing Officers, i.e. all Treasury Officers/Pension Payment Officers are requested to implement these orders without any further authorization from the Accountant General (A&E), Andhra Pradesh & Telangana Hyderabad/ Director of State Audit, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad.

23. The expenditure is allocable among the various States in accordance with the provisions of G.O.Ms.No.198 Finance Department, dated.10.07.1969, G.O. Ms. No. 97 Finance (PSC) Department, dated.07.05.2014, G.O.Ms.No.122 Finance (Pen. I) Department, dated 22.05.2014 and also as per instructions issued vide Circular Memo No. 9665/125/PSC/2014 Finance (PSC) Department dated 06.05.2014.

24. In respect of the categories of employees who are not covered for payment through the Treasuries, the expenditure shall be debited to the Pension Funds of the concerned Institutions/ Bodies.

25. Any pension consolidations contrary to the above procedure are liable for revision of pension and the excess amount paid thereon shall be recovered from the Dearness Relief of the concerned without any notice.

ORDER:

In the Budget for 2001-2002, the Government of India have announced that a new Pension Scheme based on defined contribution will be introduced to those who enter Central Government service including the All India Services, such as Indian Administrative Service, Indian Police Service and Indian Foreign Service (Defence, Railways, Posts, Telecom, Autonomous Bodies and Scientific Organizations) after 1.10.2001. The Government of India had constituted a High Power Committee with Sri B.K. Bhattacharya, former Chief Secretary, Government of Karnataka as Chairman to go into pension reform with the specific reference to recommending a contribution scheme. Based on the recommendation of the above Committee, Government of India introduced a Contributory Pension Scheme to all its employees in place of the existing non-contributory Defined Benefit Pension Scheme primarily guided by the long-term fiscal interest of the State with effect from 1-1-2004.

2. Government of Andhra Pradesh after careful consideration, decided to adopt the Government of India's a New Pension Scheme based on Defined Contributions for the employees of the State, who are newly recruited on or after 1-9-2004. Under the new Contributory Pension Scheme, each employee has to contribute a certain amount and Government may contribute a certain amount. **The New Contributory Pension Scheme is not applicable to the already existing / serving, employees of the Government of Andhra Pradesh.**
3. Accordingly, the following orders are issued:

- (i) A New Contributory Pension Scheme based on defined contributions will be introduced to all the newly recruited employees. This will apply to all the employees who are recruited on or after 1-9-2004 and whose pay and allowances are drawn from the Consolidated Fund of the State, including all the new recruits of all the tiers of all the Rural and Urban Local Bodies, Universities etc.,
- (ii) The employee's contribution and the Government contribution, if any, towards the scheme shall be spelt out separately.
- (iii) After issue of detailed orders from Government of India, introducing new scheme to their employees, the State Government will, if necessary, modify these orders and issue rules and regulations for the Contributory Pension Scheme for State Government employees recruited on or after 1-9-2004.

4. The following notification will be published in the extraordinary issue of the Andhra Pradesh Gazettee dated 22-9-2004

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendment to the Andhra Pradesh Revised Pension Rules, 1980.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st September 2004.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in part-I after rule 2 (f) the following shall be added, namely:-

“(g) (i) These rules shall not apply to all the Government Servants appointed on or after 1-9-2004, to services and posts in connection with the affairs of the State which are borne on pensionable establishment, whether temporary, or permanent.

(ii) These rules shall not apply to all appointments, whether temporary or permanent, made on or after 01-09-2004 in all the State Public Sector Undertakings, whose pay and allowances are drawn from the Consolidated Fund of the State or not.

(iii) These rules shall not apply to all appointments, whether temporary or permanent, made on or after 01-09-2004 of all the tiers of the Rural and Urban Local Bodies such as the Gram Panchayats, Mandal Parishads, Zilla Parishads, Municipalities, Municipal Corporations, Urban Development Authorities, Co-operative and Urban Local Bodies, Zilla Grandhalaya

Samsthas, Agriculture Marketing Committees, including all the Universities in the State, including all the Institutions functioning under the Universities, whose pay and allowances are drawn from the Consolidated Fund of the State or not.

(iv) These Rules shall not apply to appointments, whether temporary or permanent made on or after 01-09-2004 into all the Institutions receiving Grant-in-Aid from the Government.

(v) These rules shall not apply to appointments, whether temporary or permanent, made on or after 01-09-2004 to all Co-operative Institutions, Autonomous Corporations, whose pay and allowances are drawn from the Consolidated Fund of the State or not.”

In the Government Order read above, Government have introduced the Contributory Pension Scheme to the Andhra Pradesh employees who are recruited on or after 1-9-2004. Under the new Contributory Pension Scheme introduced to the Central Government employees, General Provident Fund Scheme is not applicable to the newly recruited employees. Government have examined the issue in respect of the State Government employees including all the new employees / posts, whose pay and allowances are drawn from the Consolidated Fund of the State etc., and direct that the existing General Provident Fund (Andhra Pradesh) Scheme will not be applicable to the newly recruited employees who are covered under Contributory Pension Scheme introduced with effect from 1-9-2004.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st September, 2004.

ORDER:

In the Government Orders read above, Government have introduced a new Contributory Pension Scheme based on Defined Contributions for all the employees, who are recruited on or after 1-9-2004. In order to implement the Contributory Pension Scheme, the following further orders are issued:

- (i) It is mandatory for all the new employees, who are recruited on or after 1-9-2004 to become members of the Scheme. Each employee will pay a monthly contribution of 10% of the Basic Pay and DA from his salary to the Contributory Pension Scheme.
- (ii) A matching contribution will be made by the State Government for each employee, who contributes to the scheme.
- (iii) The contribution towards Contributory Pension Scheme shall be recovered from the salary of the employees every month as is done now for General Provident Fund.
- (iv) Accountant General (A&E) Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad will maintain the accounts for the Contributory Pension Scheme as in the case of General Provident Fund. Index numbers to the employees who join the Contributory Pension Scheme will be allotted by Accountant General (A&E) A.P. Hyderabad on receipt of applications from the Heads of the Departments/Heads of Offices in the prescribed form annexed to this order (Annexure-I). Index numbers will be in separate types or series for (i) Government employees (ii) Employees of Aided Educational Institutions and (iii) Other employees.
- (v) Nomination has to be filed at the time of admission and has to be revised upon marriage of the subscriber and thereafter once in five

years. Necessary entry to the effect of filing the nomination along with name of nominee(s) should be noted in the Service Register on the concerned employee.

- (vi) Schedule of recovery to be attached to the Pay bill showing the Contribution to Pension Scheme has been prescribed separately for Government employees as in Annexure II and the employees of the Aided Educational Institutions as in Annexure III. Each Drawing and Disbursing Officers should prepare the schedule and enclose along with the Pay Bill.
- (vii) The amount recovered from the Pay Bill shall be credited to the following new Deposit Head of Account by the Pay and Accounts Offices / Treasuries / Sub-Treasuries **in respect of Government employees.**

- (ix) The recovery schedules attached to the Pay bills by the Drawing and Disbursing Officers shall be removed and handed over to Accounts Officer, Fund Management, Office of the Accountant General (A&E), Hyderabad in a separate cover by Treasury Officers / Pay and Accounts Officers every month.
- (x) The reasons for non-recovery from a particular employee in any month should be furnished by the Drawing and Disbursing Officers concerned in the recovery schedule without fail.
- (xi) The Government contribution and the employees contribution will be adjusted by the Accountant General every month and the total of both contributions have to be transferred to Pension Fund Regulatory and

Development Authority or any agency authorised by Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority for this purpose on monthly basis after obtaining clearance from Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA). ORDER:

In the Government Order 5th read above, orders were issued constituting Ninth Pay Revision Commission and Government appointed Sri. C.S. Rao, IAS, (Retd) as Pay Revision Commissioner. In the Government Order 6th read above, the terms of reference of the Pay Revision Commissioner were laid down.

2. The Ninth Pay Revision Commission submitted its report to the Government on 05.12.2009 and recommended, inter alia, that, **“The Commission therefore recommends grant of Maternity leave to the married women employees of the State up to 180 days on par with the employees of Government of India subject to the condition that the same would be available up to 2 surviving children only”.**

3. In the Government orders 1st and 2nd read above, orders are issued to the effect that married female Government servants, temporary or permanent, shall be granted maternity Leave for a period of 90 days. In the Government Order 3rd read above, orders were issued that the Maternity Leave to the married female Government servants shall be granted to those with less than two surviving children. In the Government orders 4th read above, orders were issued enhancing the maternity leave to the married female Government servants, temporary or permanent, from 90 days to 120 days.

4. The 9th PRC in their report observed that, the Government of India earlier issued orders enhancing the Maternity Leave to 135 days and it was further enhanced to 180 days based on the recommendations of 6th CPC. The Employees Associations have requested to extend the same to the Women employees working in the State Government also. PRC 2005 did not recommend the extension of this leave from 120 to 135 days on the ground that a period of 120 days is considered adequate and since paternity leave is also recommended. The recommendation of 6th CPC up to 180 days was based on the guidelines of Ministry of H & FW which recommends nursing of children up to the age of 6 months. Hence, the Commission recommends grant of Maternity leave to the married women employees of the State up to 180 days on par with the employees of Government of India subject to the condition that the same would be available up to 2 surviving children only.

5. After careful consideration of the report, Government decided to accept the recommendations of the Pay Revision Commissioner and hereby order that the grant maternity leave on full pay to married women employees of State Government is enhanced from 120 days to 180 days on par with the employees of the Govt. of India subject to the condition that it shall be granted to those with less than two surviving children only.

6. These orders shall come into force with immediate effect. Those who are availing Maternity Leave of 120 days as on the date of issue of G.O may continue till they complete 180 days of Maternity Leave. Those who have already completed 120 days of Maternity Leave and still continuing on other type of leave are not eligible to avail this benefit. The employees who have already availed 120 days of Maternity Leave and joined duty are also not eligible to avail this benefit.

Sub: Paternity Leave to Male Government employees – Certain Clarification – Issued.

In the reference 1st cited, it was ordered that the competent authority may grant paternity leave on full pay to married male Government employees, temporary or permanent, for a period of 15 days subject to the condition that it shall be granted to those with less than two surviving children.

In the Circular Memo. 2nd cited, it was clarified that the paternity leave has to be availed by the married male Government employee from the date when his wife has delivered the baby.

The 9th Pay Revision Commission, 2008 among other things, with regard to sanction of Paternity Leave to married male Govt. employees, observed that as per the clarification issued by Government of India in O.M.No. 13018/2/98-Estt.(L), dated 16-7-1999 the employees of Government of India can avail paternity leave either before 15 days or within a period of 6 months from the date of delivery. Hence, the Commission, therefore, recommended to issue revised clarificatory instructions on the lines issued by the Government of India in its O.M. dt. 16-7-1999 in so far it relates to the grant of paternity leave.

Government hereby further clarify that the paternity leave by married male Govt. employees can be availed either before 15 days or within a period of 6 months from the date of delivery.

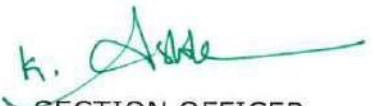
