# NCC ACTIVITIES 2024-2025

## 1.YOGA DAY CELEBRATIONS -2024

The NCC hosted the **YOGA Day** Celebrations at **SVSSC GDC SULLURPET** on June 21, 2024. The day promotes physical, mental, and spiritual wellness, inspiring individuals worldwide to integrate yoga into their daily routines. The event was attended by 35 cadets.
