Savitribai Phule was one of the first female teachers in India, a social reformer, and poet. Along with her husband, Jyotiba Phule in Maharashtra, she played a vital role in improving women's rights in India. She is considered to be the pioneer of India's feminist movement.

The college principal, Dr. SLB. SANKARA SARMA garu, highlighted her noteworthy endeavors to educate and liberate child widows, promoting a shift in societal attitudes towards the remarriage of widows. Sri. Sarth Babu, Lecturer in History, spoke her social reforms. Smt. E. Sunitha, Lecturer in English and Smt. D. Usha Rani, Lecturer in Mathematics addressed the gathering about women education. and Smt. A REPORT ON SANKRANTHI SAMBARALU

Introduction:

Sankranti Sambaralu is a widely celebrated Hindu festival in India, occurring annually with joyous festivities in the month of January. The three-day celebration of Bhogi, Sankranti, and Kanuma marks Sankranti as a significant festival in Andhra Pradesh, bringing immense joy and ushering in the New Year with festive cheer across the entire state. During this time, individuals offer prayers to Goddess Lakshmi Devi, seeking prosperity, knowledge, and a bright future.

Sankranti, known as 'Makara Sankranti,' is observed to signify the commencement of the harvest season in India. This festival is widely celebrated throughout the country, with a special emphasis on states like Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, and Maharashtra. In Andhra Pradesh, Makara Sankranti unfolds over three days, showcasing the cultural richness of the state as every corner resonates with the festive spirit.

During the celebration of Sankranti in Andhra Pradesh, individuals adorn themselves as characters from mythology. On Bhogi Panduga, the first day, old articles are burnt, while the second day, Pedda Panduga or Sankranti, is marked by elaborate festivities where people don new clothes, offer prayers to God and host feasts for guests. Traditionally, Makara Sankranti included the popular game of cockfighting, but it has been prohibited in Andhra Pradesh. The third day, Kanuma Panduga, is dedicated to enjoying meat dishes after indulging in excessive sweets.

In order to familiarize the student community with our rich culture and traditions, SVSSC Govt. Degree College in Sullurpet, Tirupati District, Andhra Pradesh, has undertaken the organization of the "**SANKRANTHI SAMBARALU PROGRAM**" in celebration of Pongal.

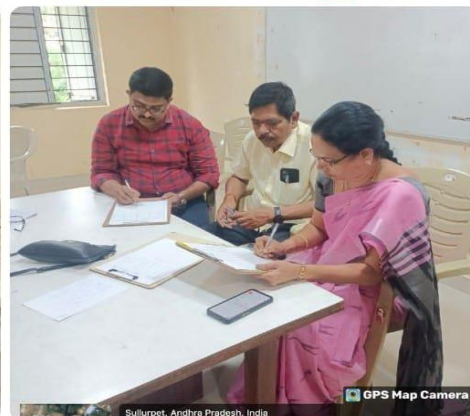
Day wise events conducted and the committees constituted for the smooth conduction of the events are as follows.

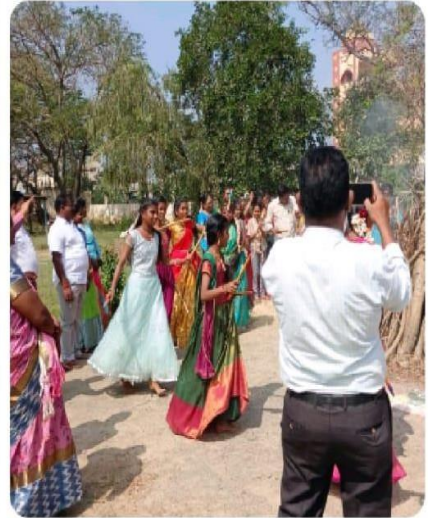

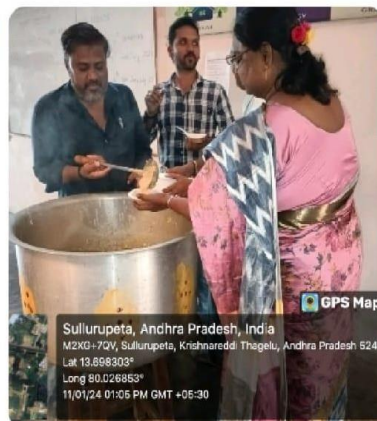

Introduction:

National Service Scheme popularly known as NSS was launched in Gandhi's Birth Centenary Year 1969, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports Govt. of India. The scheme was launched simultaneously in 37 Universities involving 40,000 students with primary focus on the development of personality of students through community service and promotion of National solidarity. In India, the idea of involving students in the task of national service dates back to the times of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of the nation. The central theme which he tried to impress upon his student was that they should always keep before them, their social responsibility. The first duty of the students should be, not to treat their period of study as one of the opportunities for indulgence in intellectual luxury, but for preparing themselves for final dedication in the service of those who provided the sinews of the nation with the national goods & services so essential to society. Advising them to form a living contact with the community in whose midst their institution is located, he suggested that instead of undertaking academic research about economic and social disability, the students should do "something positive so that the life of the villagers might be raised to a higher material and moral level". NSS works on the premise that it is possible to awaken the villagers and slum dwellers to their responsibilities and develop in them the confidence, to tackle their common problems with energy, enthusiasm and in a co-operative spirit, based on mutual aid and self-reliance. The role of students is limited as activists, enablers, catalytic agents with wider communities and as programme aids.

The Main Objectives of National Service Scheme(NSS)are:

- Understand the community in which they work.
- Understand themselves in relation to their community.
- Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving
- Develop among them a sense of social and civic responsibility.
- Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems.
- Develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities.
- Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes.

Day-1

(Thursday, 25th January, 2024)

Activity: Inauguration Program

We have started our special camp from SVSSC GDC Campus on 25.01.2024. Around 09.00 AM we reached the Village. We have started our Special Camp with Inauguration program. After that we had a meeting with village representatives and discussed our action plan of Special camp. We started our Day 1 activity with a prayer song in the Government School along with school children. And we have received very positive response from the parents and students. We have ended Day-1 activity with Clean and green by clearing unwanted bushes and wastage around the School premises and Plantation done.



Day-2

(Friday, 26th January, 2024)

Activity: Ground cleaning in the School

The second Day of our camp is started with cleaning school surroundings. To inculcate in young kids a green spirit of environment conservation. To educate and motivate school students towards tree plantation for maintaining the ecological balance and a healthier atmosphere. To encourage school authorities to form eco-clubs for providing students with practical knowledge about the various methods of nurturing their plants and environment along side. To increase the green cover of the denuded area of these states by planting native trees that support local biodiversity. And rally on Environmental Awareness in the Village. On fifth Day of our Special camp we conducted Medical Camp in the MPUP School premises Karijatha Village. The health checkup programme started at around 10:30am at health camp site in Karijathavillage along with Dr. ,Medical Officer PHC Tada dentistry and members of General Health checkup Free drugs were dispensed. Main complaints among the adult population were related to back pain and knee pain and weretreated symptomatically.

All adults were screened for hypertension and follow up was done for the known hypertensives. Patients with altered findings and poor adherence to the old treatment were referred to higher centres for further need. Complaints regarding vision and other ophthalmic complaints were screened and treated by ophthalmologist from Usha Kiran hospital. Dental problems were assessed and treated by department of communitydentistry form JSS Dental College. Students of Government School of classes 1 to 4th are also underwent General Health Checkup. Our Principal Dr.S.L.B.Shankara Sarma Garu guided to Govt School students regarding career guidance.

Dr. , medical officer, gave talk to students of Government School. he gave talk to girls regarding menstruation and menstrual hygiene she gave talk to boys about general hygiene and substance abuse. Under the help of y, along with 50 members of NSS Volunteers, Gram Panchayat President, the program was successfully conducted.

Activity: Awareness program on water conservation

On 6th Day of our Special Camp our Volunteers reached conducted Awareness program on water conservation. The 6th Day activities ended with watering of Plants.
