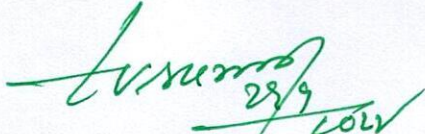

ORDER:

The Hon'ble High Court in WP No. 16290 of 2007 and WP No. 2105 of 2023 underscored the pivotal role of the Competent Authority in regulating admissions to unaided institutions and for issuing operating guidelines. In compliance with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the Competent Authority and the Chairman, Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education issues the following **Operating Guidelines for admission of candidates under Category-B (Management Quota) for OAMDC-2025**, applicable to all **Private Unaided Degree Colleges and Unaided Programmes in Aided Colleges** in the State of Andhra Pradesh, that are binding to all Managements of the Colleges and Students.

1. Competent Authority

The **Chairman, A.P. State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE)** shall be the Competent Authority for approval and ratification of Category-B admissions for OAMDC-2025.

2. Applicability

These guidelines shall apply to all Private Unaided Degree Colleges and Unaided Programmes in Aided Colleges offering Undergraduate Programmes in **Arts, Science, Commerce, Social Sciences, Management, Computer Applications, and Social Work**, participating in **OAMDC–2025**.

3. Distribution of Seats

As per G.O.Ms.No.55:

- **70% of seats** in each programme shall be filled under **Category–A (Convenor Quota)** through online admissions (OAMDC).
- The remaining **30% of seats** shall be filled under **Category–B (Management Quota)** by the managements of private unaided institutions and unaided programmes in aided colleges, subject to these guidelines and subsequent ratification by APSCHE.

4. Notification by Colleges

Each college shall publish a **notification** in at least one leading English and Telugu daily newspaper and upload the same on its website, clearly indicating:

- Programme-wise intake and number of Category–B seats,
- Eligibility criteria,
- Schedule for receipt of applications, and
- Registration fee payable by candidates.

A dedicated login facility is provided to all colleges on the OAMDC portal (<https://oamdc.ucanapply.com>) for online submission and monitoring of Category–B admissions.

5. Eligibility Criteria

- (a) Candidates shall have passed the **Two-Year Intermediate Examination** (A.P. BIE) or any equivalent examination as per Annexure-II of G.O.Ms.No.34.
- (b) Minimum marks: 35% aggregate as per G.O.Ms.No 56 Higher Education (CE) Department, Dt. 20.10.2021.
- (c) Candidates already admitted under Category–A (OAMDC) must cancel their admission before applying under Category–B.

6. Merit

Admissions shall be made in strict adherence to the merit of the candidates.

7. Admission Procedure

- a) The Management shall issue and receive applications from eligible candidates, either **online** or **in person**, acknowledging receipt.
- b) Admissions shall be made purely on **merit basis**, determined by the **aggregate marks in the qualifying examination**.
- c) In case of a tie, priority shall be given in the order:
(i) Marks in group subjects, (ii) Marks in English, (iii) Seniority in age.
- d) The selection list shall be prepared separately for each programme and displayed on the college notice board and website.
- e) Admissions shall be **provisional** until ratified by APSCHE.

8. Uploading of Data

Colleges shall upload candidate details, scanned certificates, and fee payment proof into the **OAMDC Category-B module** within the notified schedule. Each institution shall ensure:

- Correct entry of candidate data,
- Upload of signed application and merit list, and
- Payment of registration fee through online mode.

9. Registration / Processing Fee

Registration/Processing fee of Rs. 500/- per candidate shall be paid by the College. The fee shall be remitted through the OAMDC portal by the college at the time of upload for ratification.

10. Ratification of Admissions

The list of candidates admitted under Category-B shall be submitted online for ratification by the **Competent Authority (Chairman, APSCHE)**.

- Proceedings for the ratification/rejection of admissions made after verification of eligibility criteria, the Council will inform the date from which approval proceedings can be downloaded through the website.

- Only **ratified admissions** shall be considered valid for reporting to the affiliating university.
- Colleges admitting students without ratification shall be liable for action under Rule 12 of G.O.Ms.No.34.

12. Fee Collection

Colleges shall collect three times of the tuition fees as approved by the **A.P. Higher Education Regulatory and Monitoring Commission (APHERMC)**. Collection of any amount beyond the prescribed fee shall be treated as **capitation fee**, inviting penal action under the **A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983**.

13. Prohibitions

- Colleges shall **not**:
 - Admit candidates beyond sanctioned intake.
 - Admit ineligible candidates or without merit.
 - Retain original certificates contrary to UGC directions.
 - Admit students after the notified closure date.
 - Collect excess or capitation fees.
 - Permit unratified candidates to attend classes or examinations.
- The Universities concerned will not allow such candidates whose admissions are not approved/ratified by the Competent Authority to appear for examinations conducted by the Universities.
- The Institution shall undertake the responsibility on the irregularities noticed by the Competent Authority.

14. Grievances and Penalties

- Any grievance related to Category–B admissions may be submitted to the **Competent Authority (APSCHE)** at <https://oamdc.ucanapply.com>.
- The Competent Authority shall have the authority to impose fine or to initiate action or both for violation of Instructions as per the GOs in vogue.

ORDER:

The Hon'ble High Court in WP No. 16290 of 2007 and WP No. 2105 of 2023 underscored the pivotal role of the Competent Authority in regulating admissions to unaided institutions and for issuing operating guidelines. Accordingly, and in continuation of the policy laid down in G.O.Ms.No. 34 (HE-CE Dept., 15-10-2020), the Chairman, A.P. State Council of Higher Education, hereby issues the following Operating Guidelines for admission of candidates into Under-Graduate Programmes under Spot Quota through OAMDC-2025.

1. Competent Authority

The **Chairman, A.P. State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE)** shall be the Competent Authority for the approval and ratification of spot admissions.

2. Scope and Applicability

These guidelines shall apply to all Private Unaided, Aided and Government Degree Colleges offering Under-Graduate Programmes in Arts, Science, Commerce, Social Sciences, Management, Computer Applications and Social Work, including Honours

courses, participating in OAMDC 2025 and University Constituent Colleges participating in OAMDC 2025.

3. Vacancy Position

After completion of the final phase of OAMDC admissions, the vacant seat position (unfilled seats after final phase) will be displayed in each college login on

<https://oamdc.ucanapply.com>

The vacancies for spot admissions shall be calculated as follows:

Vacancies for Spot Admissions = (Unfilled after Final Phase) + (Not Reported Candidates) + (Reported but Cancelled)

5. Notification by College

Each college shall issue a notification in a state-wide leading newspaper and upload the same on its website providing details of:

- Programme-wise vacancies,
- Eligibility criteria,
- Schedule of admissions, and
- Registration fee for application.

6. Eligibility Criteria

(a) The candidate shall be of Indian nationality and satisfy the Local / Non-Local status as per G.O. Ms. No. 20 Higher Education (EC) Department Dt. 12.05.2025.

(b) The candidate shall have passed the Two-Year Intermediate Examination (A.P. BIE) or any other equivalent examination recognized by the Government of A.P.

(c) Minimum marks for eligibility shall be 35% aggregate as per G.O.Ms. No 56 Higher Education (CE) Department, Dt. 20.10.2021.

(d) Candidates who have already taken admission through OAMDC 2025 shall not be eligible for Spot Admission unless their earlier admission is cancelled beforehand.

7. Verification of Original Certificates

Before preparing the merit list, colleges shall verify and retain attested copies of the following certificates:

- (a) SSC Certificate (Proof of Date of Birth)
- (b) Intermediate Marks Memos / Pass Certificate
- (c) Transfer Certificate (TC)

- (d) Study / Residence Certificate (Local Status)
- (e) Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- (f) EWS Certificate (if applicable for the current year 2025-26 only)
- (g) Aadhaar ID (not mandatory)

Admission shall be **provisional until data are uploaded and ratified by the Competent Authority.**

8. Reservation and Conversion Matrix

Admissions shall be made strictly in accordance with the Rule of Reservation laid down in G.O.Ms.No. 34 (para 8) and G.O. Ms.No. 45 (para 3).

9. Preparation of Merit List

- (a) Merit shall be based on aggregate marks in the qualifying examination.
- (b) In case of a tie, the following order be followed –
 - (i) Marks in group subjects
 - (ii) Marks in English
 - (iii) Date of Birth (senior first).
- (c) The programme-wise merit list shall be displayed on the college notice board and website.

10. Procedure for Admission

- (a) Colleges shall receive applications and prepare programme-wise merit lists following transparent criteria.
- (b) Only eligible candidates shall be admitted on the basis of merit and reservation.
- (c) Admissions are **provisional** till ratification by the Competent Authority.
- (d) Candidates admitted through spot admissions are **not eligible for Tuition Fee Reimbursement** (vide G.O.Ms.No. 66, SW Dept., 08-09-2010).

11. Uploading and Ratification Procedure

1. Colleges shall upload details of admitted candidates along with scanned copies of certificates on the OAMDC portal within the stipulated schedule.
2. The Competent Authority will validate the entries with reference to the G.O. and guidelines.
3. If deficiencies are found, colleges shall rectify them within the given time.
4. Issuance of Proceedings for ratification/rejection of admissions made after verification of eligibility criteria, the Council will inform the date from which approval proceedings can be downloaded through the website.
5. Only validated and ratified admissions shall be treated as final.

13. Registration Fee / Processing

The Registration/Processing fee per candidate is Rs. 500/- The fee shall be remitted online through the OAMDC portal while uploading data for ratification.

14. Colleges Shall STRICTLY comply with the Spot Admission schedule issued by APSCHE. **No requests of ratification shall be entertained after the given schedule.**

15. Prohibitions

1. Colleges Shall Not

- (a) Admit students beyond sanctioned intake or after the prescribed schedule.
 - (b) Allow students without approval of Competent Authority.
 - (c) Collect original certificates in contravention of UGC directions.
 - (d) Collect excess fees beyond APHERMC prescriptions.
 - (e) Admit ineligible candidates or violate reservation rules.
 - (f) Retain students whose names do not figure in the final ratified list.
2. The Universities concerned will not allow such candidates whose admissions are not approved/ratified by the Competent Authority to appear for examinations conducted by the Universities.
 3. The Institution shall undertake the responsibility on the irregularities noticed by the Competent Authority.
 4. Any violation will invite penal action and cancellation of affiliation under Rule 12 of G.O.Ms.No. 34.
