






A REPORT ON MEGA JOB FAIR HELD ON 30-09-2023

A Report on Field Trip to Nelapattu

As a part of the curriculum, the departments of Botany and Zoology organized a field trip for the 1st and 2rd B.Sc (BZC), I & III - Semester students to visited "Nelapattu Bird Sanctuary" in the Tirupati District, on 30.09.2023 to know the biodiversity in plants, different types of birds and study of environment at Nelapattu.

On 30.09.2023 we started at 10 am from SVSSC. Govt. Degree College, Sullurpeta and reached Nelapattu by 10.30 A.M. Where Divisional Forest Officer P. Samuel garu briefed about the forest area, different types of jobs, how to employment in the forest department and also explained about the plan for coming Flamingo Festival in January -2024. Then we visited forest, plants and immigrated bird's area. Students showed very much interest to collect water plants and rare voluble plant saplings and some verity of seeds for their herbarium preparation and sown. Students interacted with guide Mr. Hussen garu and know the bird's information. Students acquired knowledge about the climate conditions.
